## The 2010 South African Adult and Young Rider Dressage Championships



- SHOW DATE:** Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> September 2010
- VENUE:** Port Elizabeth Riding Club, Burgess Rd, Lorraine
- ENTRIES CLOSE:** 12 noon Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2010 – NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Incomplete entries or those submitted without proof of payment will be discarded.
- ENTRIES:** Competitors from outside of the Eastern Cape must have their entries countersigned by their Provincial Body as being correct PRIOR to submission. Any entry received without this will be discarded
- PRIZE MONEY:** Minimum of 60% of total entry fees (less all levies) and sponsorship. Prize money will be subject to a SANEF deduction of 15%.
- ENTRY FEES:** R100 Ground levy per horse (medic / security / arena staff)  
R180 per class (includes a R15 SANEF levy, R7.50 ECHS levy)
- STABLING:** R750 for the duration of the show, arriving on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2010.  
Additional R250 if arriving prior to 30<sup>th</sup> August 2010. Please note that SA Showing championship competitors will be leaving over the weekend of 28/29 August, so stable availability will be limited on Saturday and Sunday and will be allocated on a 1<sup>st</sup> come-1<sup>st</sup> served basis as entries are received.
- SHOW NUMBERS:** Each horse will be allocated a number to be used throughout the event. This number must be attached to the LEFT-HAND SIDE of the halter/headcollar and also to the bridle or numnah. If you require a printed number, please ensure that you mark this on your entry. A number will be randomly allocated to each competitor.

- HOW TO ENTER:** Complete 1 page per horse  
Complete 1 page per rider with a total entry per horse and calculate the overall amount due. This amount can be paid via bank deposit or Internet banking transfer.  
Send this entry and proof of payment to ECHS via email or fax. Any entries without proof of payment will be discarded.

HORSE INSPECTION: Horses entered in the Individual and Team Championships must be presented for an inspection as advertised in the show programme.

SANEF RIDER'S RANKING: All Championship tests for Medium and above will count towards the SANEF Rider's Ranking.

### NOTES REGARDING CLASSES 1-6 ONLY

2 qualifying tests will be ridden. The top 15 qualifying horses will be eligible to compete in the Championship class(3A/6A), the remaining horses will automatically be entered in the consolation class(3B/6B). Classes (3/6) must be entered up-front (included in your initial entry) before the closing date. Qualification will be according to the combined placings-based points of the 2 qualifying classes. In the event of a tie for 15<sup>th</sup> place all tied competitors will be allowed to compete (as per Section 37.3.3 of the SANEF dressage rules).

### **ADVANCED - NOTES FOR ADVANCED CLASSES**

No cross entries allowed between 16A and 16B.

An advanced horse/rider combination may enter only one of classes 17, 18 or 19. Class 17 is not open to any horse and rider combination that has competed in an Int I or II and obtained 62% or more.

Competitors entered in 18 or 19 must nominate by 2pm the day before the Championship classes whether they are competing in 18 or 19.

For advanced freestyle classes, a horse/rider combination may enter only one of the classes 20 or 21.

Competitors entered in 21 must nominate by 2pm the day before the Championship classes whether they are competing in 21A or 21B.
